**“Rebuilding Sri Lanka” Guideline for Submission of Public Investment Project Proposals in Response to the Disaster Situation**

This refers to the letter No NP/MEP/2024/04 dated 12.09.2024 issued by the then Secretary to the Treasury on Submission of Project Proposals for Public Investment under the Public Financial Management Act, No. 44 of 2024.

In view of the recent unprecedented floods and landslides that have affected several regions of Sri Lanka, the Government has identified the restoration, rehabilitation, and strengthening of damaged public infrastructure as an urgent national priority. Emphasis is placed not only on restoring affected assets, but also on rebuilding infrastructure in a manner that enhances resilience and reduces vulnerability to future disasters.

In terms of the provisions of the Public Financial Management Act, No. 44 of 2024, public investment projects formulated in response to natural disasters, formally declared by the Government, shall be considered outside the approved Public Investment Programme. Accordingly, the Department of National Planning has initiated the introduction of a simplified project submission and appraisal process in order to facilitate the allocation of necessary financial resources on priority basis.

Accordingly, all relevant Ministries, Departments, Provincial Councils, and other implementing agencies are hereby directed to identify and submit their prioritized development needs to the Department of National Planning (NPD) **on or before 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2026** for its recommendation in accordance with the attached format. A duly completed MS Excel soft copy shall also be emailed to [dgnp@npd.treasury.gov.lk](mailto:dgnp@npd.treasury.gov.lk) to support integration into the NPD’s digitalized data collection system.

In preparing project proposals, due consideration shall be given to the integration of disaster prevention, mitigation, and resilience-building measures within the project scope and design.
